Requirements:

1. Master's degree (or equivalent) in forestry, biological, chemical or related sciences
2. Fulfillment of the conditions for applicants to the SGGW Doctoral School
3. Experience in laboratory work in the field of planning research experiments, in particular in the field of testing biological materials
4. Knowledge of the English language enabling communication in an international research team
5. Ability to analyze data, draw conclusions and use computer programs and tools (PowerPoint, Excel, Statistica)
6. Organizational skills and ability to cope with time pressure in a 3-year project
7. High motivation for further development and the ability to work in a team
8. Experience in the field of microscopic analysis, study of the structure and properties of wood, near infrared spectroscopy and hyperspectral imaging will be an additional advantage

Description of tasks:

The doctoral student will be involved in the implementation of the project *Spectroscopic methods for Scots pine dendrometric features and wood properties characterization reflecting its provenance and genetic variation*.

The detailed tasks of the doctoral student will include:

- research on the structure and physical and chemical properties of wood,
- wood research using techniques of near infrared spectroscopy and hyperspectral imaging
- collecting data from the literature on the subject of conducted research,
- preparation of a doctoral dissertation.
